And I shall dock secure forever.

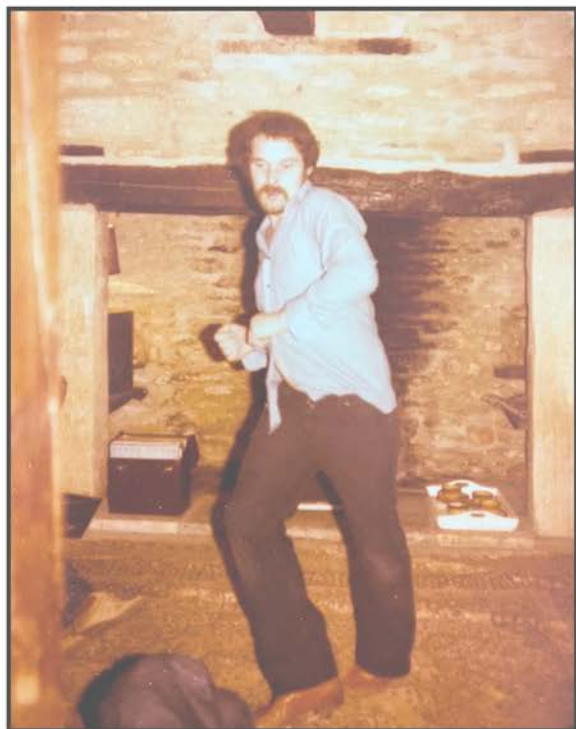
